MARTYR ANASTASIOS THE FULLER AT SALONA IN DALMATIA. Anastasios was born in Aquileia during the fourth-century reign of Diocletian. He was a fervent Christian and a maker of cloth in the town of Salona. Seeing the tortures that the holy martyrs endured for Christ, he developed a desire for martyrdom. He covered himself with the image of the cross and took himself to the judgment hall, where he declared that he was a Christian. The judge immediately had him disrobed and flogged, then beheaded and cast into the sea. A Christian woman had the saint’s body retrieved from the water, and she buried him in her garden. Later, the garden became a Christian cemetery, and a chapel was built there dedicated to St. Anastasios. Many miracles glorified the saint’s relics.

Food Donations at ramp entrance


