MARTYRS ADAUKTOS AND HIS DAUGHTER KALLISTHENE. Adauktos and Kallisthene were from fourth-century Ephesus. Adauktos was honored with the office of duke and eparch by the Christian-emperor Maximinus, who sought to marry Kallisthene. Adauktos would not permit this marriage since Maximinus was an enemy of the faith. For this Adauktos was stripped of his wealth and exiled to Melitene, where he was beheaded. Kallisthene disguised herself as a man, cutting her hair and wearing men's clothing. She left Ephesus for Nicomedia, then eight years later moved to Thrace, where she stayed with a woman whose daughter had eye damage. When Kallisthene healed her eyes, the girl asked for permission to marry Kallisthene, who was forced to reveal that she was not a man. When Maximinus died, Licinius took the throne. His wife was Constantia, who was a Christian and the sister of Constantine the Great. Kallisthene visited Constantia, and she helped raise their son. Kallisthene was given back all the property of her father and brought the relics of Adauktos back to Ephesus, where she built a church in his name. Kallisthene died peacefully and was buried near her father.
